CEDRO participated in the 7th edition of the International Beirut Energy Forum (IBEF) that was held at Le Royla from 21 to 23 September under the patronage of the Minister of Energy and Water H.E. Mr. A. Nazarian and in the presence of the Head of the EU delegation to Lebanon H.E. Ms. C. Lassen and the UNDP Resident Representative H.E. Mr. P. Lazzarini. CEDRO team was available to discuss ongoing projects and recent publications with exhibition visitors, in addition to taking part of a UNDP organized session entitled: National Renewable Energy Grid Code and PV Status Report, during which an overview of the implemented and ongoing projects have been presented.



WORK STARTED AT USEK

USEK's Hybrid PV/ Diesel system implementation was launched. The 212 KWp system currently being implemented at the university's campus in Kaslik will provide approximately 300 MWh of clean energy, equivalent to 213 tCO2 reduction, yearly, contributing to the university's road to sustainability and its commitment to reduce emissions.



GREEN BONDS

This month's technical exchange provides information about Green Bonds, a tax-exempt bond issued by qualified parties for the development of the under-utilized / under-developed lands; requirements, both technical and non-technical are listed along with real life examples.
